



Reception - Summer 1 - Once Upon A Time



	Communication and Language	Physical Development	Personal, Social and Emotional Development
Prime Areas	<p>We will spend a lot of time focussing on rhymes and poems in our stories this half term. We will pay close to attention to the sounds we can hear and identify rhyming words in the text.</p> <p>The children will hear a wide range of traditional tales and will be given the opportunity to compare and contrast different parts of these stories in whole class time.</p>	<p>We will be using large apparatus in our PE lessons this half term. We will use this to develop the children's coordination with climbing, balancing and moving in different ways.</p> <p>Staff will also create obstacle courses for the children to develop their agility and flexibility throughout the half term.</p>	<p>This half term, we will spend time talking about challenge. The children will face many different challenges during their educational journey at school and it is important for them to develop the perseverance and resilience skills to continue trying our best even when something gets difficult.</p>

Specific Areas	<p>In our Literacy sessions this half term, we will be focussing primarily on traditional tales. We will learn the story of the Three Little Pigs and change it to make it into our own unique tale.</p> <p>We will also be learning the story of The Gingerbread Man. We will make our own gingerbread men and write a set of instructions about how to make them.</p>	<p>In our Maths sessions this half term, we will learn about creating and continuing repeating patterns.</p> <p>We will continue to practise our addition and subtraction within ten, looking at changes that we can make to numbers with this process.</p> <p>The children will also begin looking at numbers to 20 and recognising the value of these.</p>	<p>During our afternoon sessions this half term, we will be learning about castles, princes and princesses, dragons and comparing characters from different traditional tales. We will also take part in some experiments with materials such as if they are waterproof or not.</p> <p>In our RE lessons, we will be learning about the Muslim celebrations of Ramadan and Eid.</p>	<p>Our role play area this half term will be a fairy tale castle.</p> <p>The children will design and make homes for the three little pigs using a range of reclaimed materials. They will use a range of equipment and joining materials to make these, and will have the opportunity to decorate them in a range of different ways.</p>
